

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE: Clark County Conservative Grassroots: “Lowden? A Resounding Hell No!”

Late evening on Monday, members of the Clark County Conservative Grassroots Coalitions, a consortium of conservative groups, wrapped up their 2010 Republican Primary Caucus. The goal: any Clark County race is debated, voted upon, and if they receive 2/3 of the vote, the winning candidate obtains a ‘Clark County Grassroots Certified’ stamp.

The most contested race of the evening was the U.S. Senate race. Unsurprisingly, a full endorsement was not reached in who should take on Reid in the fall, but in a major show of support that strengthened after heated debate, 47% voted for constitutional conservative Bill Parson. Danny Tarkanian achieved second place at 29%, Angle, third with 18%, and John Chachas obtained 6%. So there was no full endorsement in the race, or was there?

“Sue Lowden is a disaster of a candidate,” lamented one voting grassroots, Richard. “Lowden? A Resounding Hell No! She’s not a conservative. She’s more like a wolf in sheep’s clothing.” Not being able to reach a consensus on an endorsement did not stop the coalition of conservative groups from creating a special kind of anti-endorsement for Sue Lowden: “Certifiably a Reid R.I.N.O., Unanimous Endorsement of Non-Endorsement.”

Candidates that received the actual endorsement included the “Only Electable Conservative” gubernatorial candidate Mike Montandon (88%), Lieutenant Governor challenger Barbara Lee Woollen (94%), Ken Wegner of CD1 (70%), Ed Bridges of CD3 (83%), and Patrick McNaught of State Senate District 12 (76%). There were two races where voting attendees were unanimous: Glenn Greener for Assembly District 16 and Gordon Martines for Clark County Sheriff.

“The results send a clear message: the Tea Party attending, grassroots activists aren’t falling for the establishment R.I.N.O.’s,” says Jesse Law, an organizer for Citizen Awareness Network, the group sponsoring the event. “We want our country back, and we aren’t willing to settle for the good old boys that got us into this mess. The Republican Party’s image is damaged because of candidates like Republican-In-Name-Only Sue Lowden. We held this event in order to identify which candidates the real grassroots in the county support. Republican voters need to know where the tea-partiers are in the Primary.”
